## <u>ABSTRACT</u>

TSTRANSCO – Nurturing the spirit of entrepreneurship among SCs/STs, Waddera and Sagara (Uppara) Contract Cooperative societies and Individuals belonging to the said communities - Measures to promote participation in the works of all the Engineering Departments – Adopting G.O. Ms. No. 29, Dt. 26.05.2017 & G.O. Ms. No. 59, Dt. 21.05.2018 for works in TSTRANSCO – Revised Orders – Issued.

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In the ref. 1<sup>st</sup> cited, the Government of Telangana has issued orders for measures to promote participation of Co-operative Societies and individuals belonging to SCs/STs, Waddera and Sagara (Uppara) in works of all Engineering Departments stating that in order to nurture the spirit of entrepreneurship among various sections of society especially, among SCs/STs, Waddera and Sagara (Uppara) Societies and Individuals, after the Board of Chief Engineers suggested comprehensive measures to ensure greater participation of these communities in the nation building process as contractors.

In the reference 2<sup>nd</sup> cited, Special Chief Secretary to Government, Energy Department, Telangana Secretariat, Hyderabad has requested to implement the above G.O. in TS TRANSCO.

After careful consideration, TSTransco accorded approval for implementation of G.O.Ms.No.29, Dated:26.05.2017 and T.O.O Ms. No. 163, Dt. 02.05.2018 is released vide reference 3<sup>rd</sup> cited.

Meanwhile, in the ref. 4<sup>th</sup> cited the Government of Telangana has issued orders G.O.Ms.No.59, Dated: 21.05.2018 with certain relaxations/ concessions in respect of reservation of works SC/ ST contractors in Public works.

Accordingly, approval is hereby accorded to revise the T.O.O Ms. No. 163, Dt. 02.05.2018 by adopting the G.O.Ms.No.59, Dated: 21.05.2018 and G.O.Ms.No.29, Dated: 26.05.2017 in regard to entrustment of works to SCs/STs, Waddera and Sagara (Uppara) Contract Co-operative Societies and individuals, for works in TS TRANSCO, duly following the Guidelines as below:

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- The team of SC/ ST contractors include the individual SC/ ST contractors, proprietor firms, partnership firms and private limited companies promoted by the SC/ ST's and the shareholders of the SC/ STs in the proprietor ship firms. Partnership firms and private limited companies should be 100%.
- For class-III, IV & V, SC/ ST Contractors the solvency certificate is not needed. However, for Special Class, Class-I & Class-II SC/ ST contractors, the solvency certificate is required as per Departmental format. All Engineering departments shall harmonise form in accordance with format given by Indian Bankers Association and other Co-operative Banks.
- 3. Exemption of EMD:
  - (i) Exemption of EMD shall be for the works costing up to 1.00 crore (ECV).
  - (ii) However, in order to provide level playing field to all, EMD will be recovered from running bills after expenditure of 25% of the concerned works. This will also inculcate the responsibility for completion of the works.
- 4. Entrusting of works on Nomination is dispensed with, except for emergency works. The procedure as per the existing GOs for entrusting emergency works on Nomination shall be followed.
  - 5. (i) In all Public Works Departments, the works costing up to Rupees One Crore (ECV) may be reserved for SC/STs as detailed below:
    - 1. 15% to SCs and
    - 2. 6% to STs

Works for SC/ STs could be pooled together. This will ensure additional pool of contractors generated authentication and it should be reviewed after 6 months from the date of implementation.

- (ii) While calling Tenders for the SC/ ST reserved works, when there is no response upto 3rd call, it shall be considered to invite under general category.
- (iii) For Tenders called for on e-procurement single bid received for SC/ ST reserved works, even for the 1st call of tenders, shall be considered.
- (iv) List of works reserved for SC/ ST Contractors shall be displayed by respective tender inviting authority twice in a financial year.
- 6. The qualification criteria for SC/ ST Contractors, shall be followed as per G.O. Ms. No. 66, I&CAD (Reforms) Department, Dated: 20-04-2015.
- 7. The Bid Capacity for SC/ ST Contractors shall be followed as per Standard Bid document (SBD), i.e. 3AN-B.

- 8. The payment of Mobilisation advance is dispensed with and shall not be given again.
- 9. Among the ready bills for payment depending on the release made the bills pertaining to SC/ ST Contractors should be cleared on priority.
- 10. The Bonafideness of SC/ ST Contractors shall be considered based on the SC/ ST Certificate issued by the Mandal Tahasildar.
- 11. The insisting of foundation training by the NAC to SC/ ST Contractors shall not be mandatory. However, the Contractors with NAC Training shall be given priority.
- 12. The penalty clause for reserved works shall be followed as per Standard Bid Document. Action shall be taken against the erring contractors reported if any, as per penalty clause.
- Government also consider the recommendation of the Board of Chief Engineers (BOCEs) and Engineers-in-Chief (ENCs)Committee to reserve 3% of works exclusively to Waddera/ Sagara communities in addition to SC/ ST quota, with relaxations/ concessions on par with SC/ ST Communities.
- 14. Based on 4<sup>th</sup> BOCE Minutes of Meeting, the methodology for implementation of Clause 7.7(i) of G.O.Ms. 59, Dt. 21.05.2018 is clearly mentioned in the ANNEXURE.

### Directions to Tender inviting authorities:

- 1. The above cycle of 100 works in serial shall be maintained till its completion irrespective of Financial year to satisfy the provisions of GO Ms No 59 and repeated in similar fashion.
- 2. The Tender inviting authority (Division/Circle/HODs level) shall maintain the above Register of works invited to ascertain the reservation of works as per provisions of GO Ms No 59.
- 3. The Tender inviting authority shall have discretion in reservation of works to the said communities as per nature and suitability of works and ensure that any 5 works to SCs, 2 works to STs and one work to Waddera/Sagara communities is allotted within a cluster of 33 works. The decision of Tender inviting authority is final and binding in this regard.
- 4. In the NITs of such earmarked works, it may be mentioned under name of work that ("Invited under earmarked works - SCs/STs/ Waddera/Sagara (Uppara) communities (as the case may be) are only eligible to participate").
- 5. The Tender inviting authority to the extent possible shall judiciously earmark/ allocate works to SC/ST/Waddera (Sagara) Communities such that the works allotted to these communities broadly satisfies both in numerical and financial terms as per their share of reservation in the said GO.
